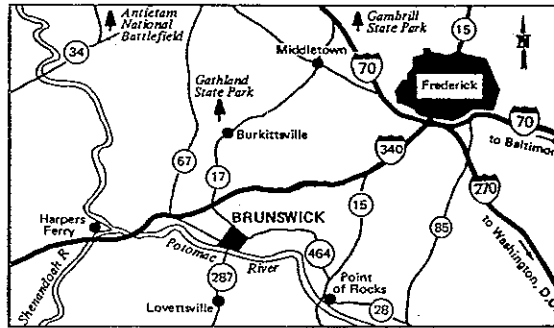


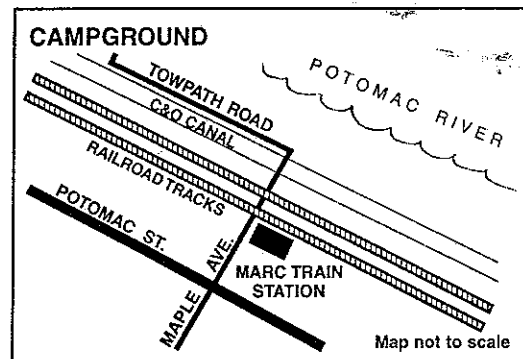
Brunswick Family Campground is operated by the City of Brunswick, Maryland. Brunswick is a small city with a population of 5,000. It is on the National Register of Historic Places as an example of a 1900's era railroad town.



DIRECTIONS TO THE CAMPGROUND:

Hikers/Bikers on the C&O Canal towpath:
The campground is located between mileposts 54 and 55.

Vehicles: From U.S. 340, exit on Rt. 17 south to Brunswick. Follow Rt. 17 as it makes a right turn toward downtown Brunswick. (Follow MARC train signs) Proceed south 1 mile to a traffic circle, taking Petersville Road off the circle. Go one block and make a right turn on Maple Avenue. Take Maple past the train station, crossing two sets of railroad tracks. Turn left onto gravel towpath road. Follow the towpath road 3/4 mile to the Campground on the right

Brunswick Family Campground

is on a secluded stretch of land between the Potomac River and the C&O Canal National Historical Park in Frederick County, Maryland. The Canal's scenic towpath winds past the Campground and provides the only road access to this riverfront camping area.

Relax and take in peaceful river views from your campsite or enjoy the many recreational activities available for campers of all ages:

- Boating and fishing on the river.
- Bicycling, walking and running on the canal towpath.
- Playing horseshoes, volleyball, shuffleboard or basketball.
- Playing in the kid's playground
- Listening to musical entertainment on special weekends.
- Seeing wildflowers, birds, and wildlife along the river trails.
- Sitting by a campfire.
- Sleeping under the stars.

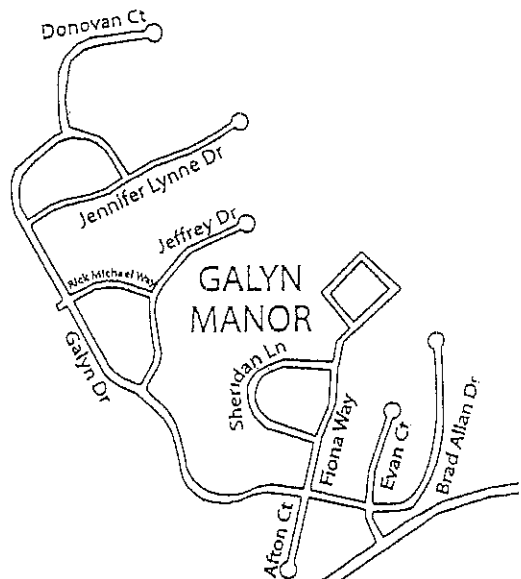
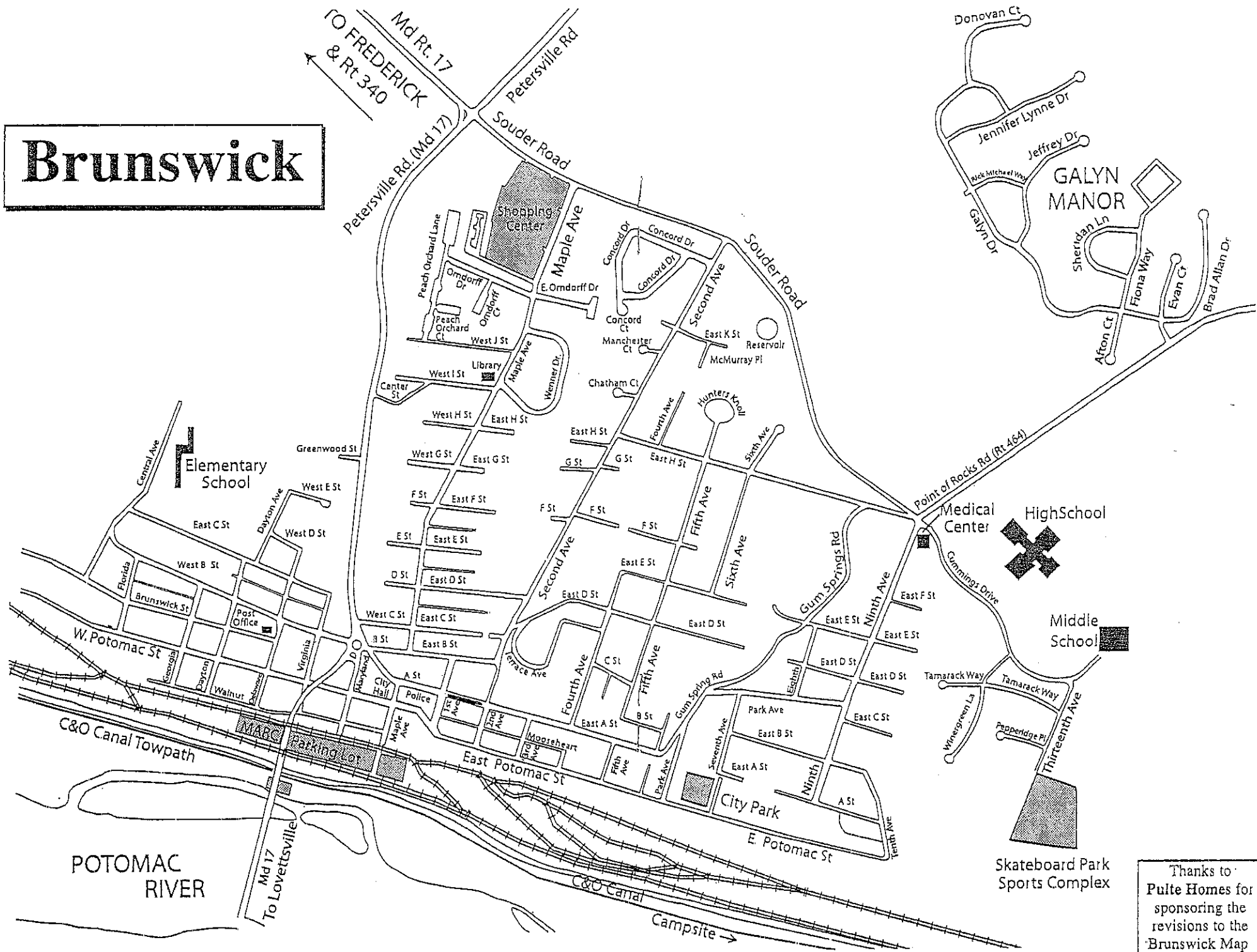
